These activities require voluntary donations from members like you. No dollar from union dues is used to fund these school board races.

SAEA Political **Action Committee (PAC) works hard to get pro-education school board candidates elected as trustees.** Legally, your SAEA dues cannot be used to finance our involvement in school board races.

The contribution process is simple. The amount you select below will be deducted from your pay warrant monthly from September to June. The contribution continues until you opt out. We have a campaign to endorse every two years. **Campaigns are expensive, and the more money we raise, the better campaign we can run for our endorsed candidates.**
